



## **Trip Leader Duties and Instructions**

- Trip leaders must be over the age of 21.
- Contact Ita to find out if there are any new safety concerns
- Approve cars in advance (type, number of seatbelts, equipment, etc.)
- Designate pre-determined assembly point with drivers
- Assign team leaders to coordinate food, games, projects, etc.
